HIGHER EDUCATION

Higher education institutions offer more than 600 study programmes taught in English.

You can choose between five types of Danish higher education institutions:

Universities

- > first, second and third cycle degree programmes
- > broad variety of subjects

University colleges

- > first cycle programmes
- professionally oriented programmes in a broad variety of subjects

Business academies

- > short cycle and first cycle degree programmes
- professionally oriented programmes that are focused mostly on business

Artistic higher education institutions

- > first, second and third cycle degree programmes
- programmes in fields such as architecture, fine and performing arts, design and music

Maritime education and training

- > short cycle and first cycle degree programmes
- > professionally oriented programmes

Q DEGREES

ACADEMY PROFESSION (AP) DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- duration: between 2 and 2.5 years (120-150 ECTS)
- a combination of theory and practice
- work placements in Danish or overseas companies
- ▶ institutions: university colleges and business academies

BACHELOR'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- Professional Bachelor's degree (university colleges)
 - > strong focus on professional practice
 - > duration: 3 to 4.5 years (180-270 ECTS)
 - institutions: university colleges, schools of maritime education and training
- University Bachelor's degree (universities)
 - > research-based
 - > duration: 3 to 3.5 years (180-210 ECTS)
 - > institutions: universities, artistic higher education institutions

MASTER'S DEGREE PROGRAMMES

- advanced, research-based course
- duration: 1 to 2 years (60-120 ECTS)
- ▶ institutions: universities, artistic higher education institutions

PHD PROGRAMMES

- academic research degree
- duration: 3 years (180 ECTS)
- ▶ institutions: universities, artistic higher education institutions

APPLICATION

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate programmes

- secondary school leaving diploma
- good knowledge of Danish for programmes taught in Danish
- good knowledge of English for programmes taught in English
- specific entry requirements that apply to the study programme

CENTRAL APPLICATION PROCESS

- Apply online from 1st February to 15th March.
- For each programme you apply to, you have to create a signature page. The signature page will be generated on <u>www.optagelse.dk</u> after finishing the digital application. You have to print it, sign it, and send it to the higher education institution that offers the programme.
