SHORT CYCLE

- > Técnico Superior

FIRST CYCLE

- ▶ Bachelor / *Grado* (3-4 years; 180-240 ECTS)

SECOND CYCLE

- ▶ Master / *Máster*
 - > Official University Master's degree / *Máster Universitario* (1-2 years; 60, 90 or 120 ECTS)*
 - > Official Master's Degree in Arts / *Máster en Enseñanzas Artísticas* (1-2 years; 60-120 ECTS)**
 - > Título Superior de Enseñanzas artísticas

*Registered in RUCT (Register of Universities, Centres and Degrees)

**Registered in RCD (State Register of Non-University Teaching Centres)

THIRD CYCLE

- ▶ PhD / *Doctorado*

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

University access

- ▶ *Bachillerato**
 - > Secondary school leaving certificate
 - > International Baccalaureate
 - > European Baccalaureate

*non-EU students must apply for a recognition procedure (*homologación*).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

! Admission criteria may vary from one university to another!

1. Visit the university's website to find out if

- ▶ the chosen university uses the UNEDasiss accreditation system (admission scores) provided by the National University Distance of Education (UNED) <https://unedasiss.uned.es/>
- ▶ you have to meet other university-specific criteria that can be provided by UNEDasiss, such as:
 - > evidence of Bachillerato Modality (*Modalidad de Bachillerato*),
 - > recognition of subjects
 - > specific competence tests (*PCE – Pruebas de Competencias Específicas*),
 - > Spanish language accreditation.

2. Apply online within the deadlines

- ▶ UNEDasiss accreditation: from February onwards
- ▶ University enrolment deadlines: vary from one university to another. Pre-enrolment at state universities often ends in July.

► specific competency tests (*PCE*)

> May/June session: register in February-April

> September session: register in July

> *Pruebas de Competencias Específicas*

- can improve the admission score (up to 4 points);
- are mandatory for certain courses (medicine, veterinary medicine, physiotherapy...);
- are relevant to the content of the chosen GRADO you wish to pursue.

It is recommended to take these exams when the number of applicants for the desired studies exceeds the number of available places (cf. *nota de corte*: minimum grade required to join a selective course).

TUITION FEES

PUBLIC UNIVERSITIES

To calculate the exact cost of education, simply multiply the number of credits required to obtain the degree by the price per credit indicated on the university's website.

Bachelors (*Grados*)

- ▶ 240 credits
- ▶ Between €10 and €25 per credit

Masters

- ▶ Between 60 and 120 credits
- ▶ Between €15 and €50 per credit

PRIVATE UNIVERSITIES

Private universities have the right to set their own fees. As a result, tuition fees can be relatively high.
